03 June 2024 – AURORA. Municipal Census - Community-Based Monitoring System (CBMS) Coordinating Board of San Luis was convened for the second time last May 13, 2024 at the Municipal Bahay Kanlungan, Brgy. 2 San Luis, Aurora to discuss and provide updates on the upcoming Integration of 2024 Mid-decade Census of Population (POPCEN) – CBMS Operations. This was presided by Hon. Ariel A. De Jesus, Municipal Mayor represented by Municipal Planning and Development Coordinator, Fidel A. Herminigildo. and Philippine Statistics Authority – Aurora, Officer-in-Charge, Ferdinand E. Santiago represented by Statistical Specialist II, Ferdinand P. Peralta and Assistant Statistician, Arlyn B. Santiago.

The meeting aimed to discuss the operation's process, but it also served as an opportunity to present the primary objectives of integrating the CBMS with the 2024 POPCEN, which are to update the country's population count and provide population data to government executives, policymakers, and planners for use in making social and economic planning decisions. Streamline the identification of recipients of social protection programs; conduct a detailed poverty study, and the support that the MCCB




mentioned in the first meeting, further explaining and finalizing the assistance needed in the operation.
