## Update on Philippine Identification System Registration in Bataan as of September 2024

### Total Registrants as of 30 September 2024

A total registrant of 711,036 Bataeños have been registered in the Philippine Identification System Step 2 in the Province of Bataan. Table 1 shows that 83.32% of the provincial target (853,373) is successfully registered in the Philippine Identification System. It is composed of 129,140 who are 1 to 14 years old and 581,896 who are 15 years old and above.

A total registrant of 6,194 Bataeños have been registered for the month of September 2024 in the PhilSys Step 2 in the Province of Bataan. Table 2 shows that 63.72% of the target workload for the month of September 2024 (9,720) was successfully registered in the PhilSys.



### Registrants per Municipality

The City of Balanga tops the highest registrants with 107.49% based on the target from 2020 Census of Population and Housing (111,980 registrants out of 104,173 population). In the City of Balanga located the PhilSys fixed registration center which covers/accommodates the registrants in the whole province of Bataan. Next, the municipality of Samal at 88.64% (33,950 out of 38,302) placing the second highest accomplishment. Then, the municipality of Orani with 88.32% (62,123 out of 70,342). The least reported percentage of accomplishment was Mariveles at 71.44% (107,017 out of 149,809).

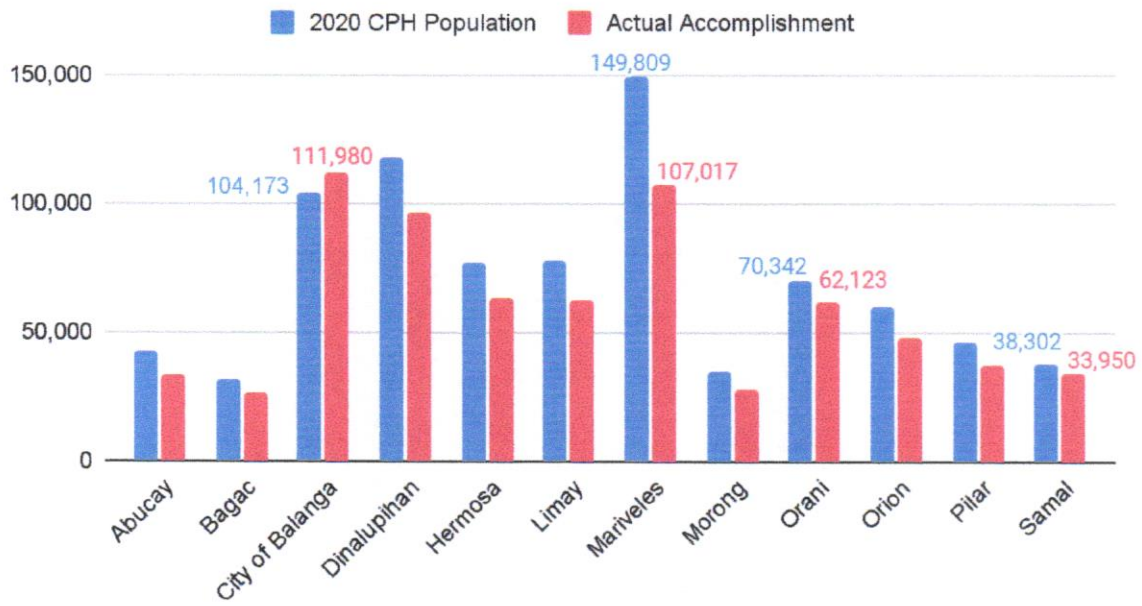

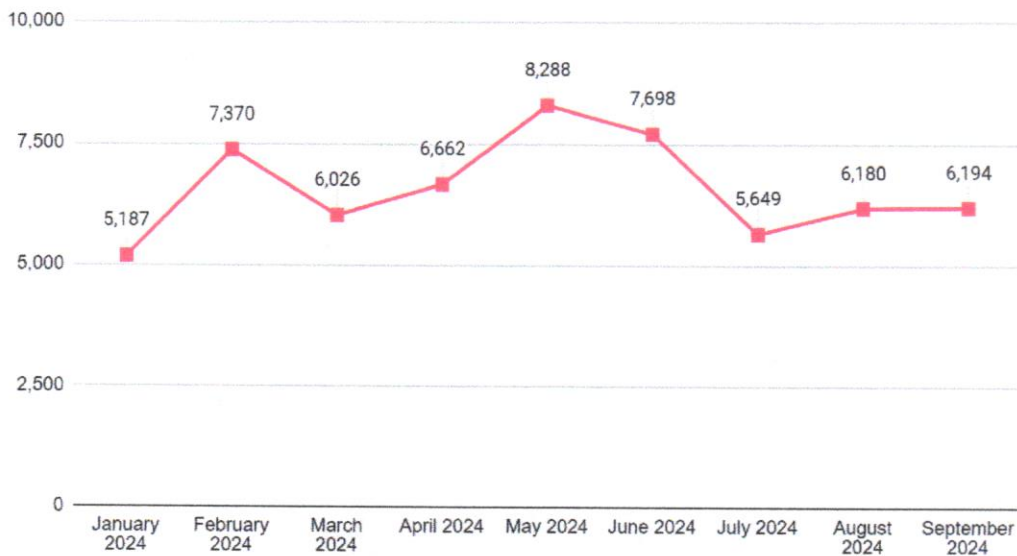


**Figure 1.** Total Registrants in the Philippine Identification System Step 2 by Municipality: Bataan, January 2021 to 30 September 2024.

The number of registrants increased during the month of September. In coordination with the Local Government Units (LGUs), Department of Social Welfare and Development (DSWD) in the Bataan to conduct PhilSys registration and authentication of PhilSys Card Number, issuance of ePhilID, and saturation of the area was done this month. PSA Bataan went to far-flung areas to extend the services provided. Furthermore, there were 5,187 in January, 7,370 in February, 6,026 in March, 6,662 in April, 8,288 in May, 7,698 in June, 5,649 in July 2024, 6,180 in August and 6,194 in September 2024.

### PhilSys Step 3- Delivery of Philippine ID

Concerning the total number of received PhilID's as per the delivered, there is still a total of ongoing deliveries with 36 PhilID's. In total, 99.99% delivered and 5,320 return-to-sender endorsements to PSA Regional Office.

The total ePhilID issued in the province was 183,469 out of 195,849 target ePhilID up to August 2024, the figure is equivalent to 93.68% issued of the target as of August 2024.

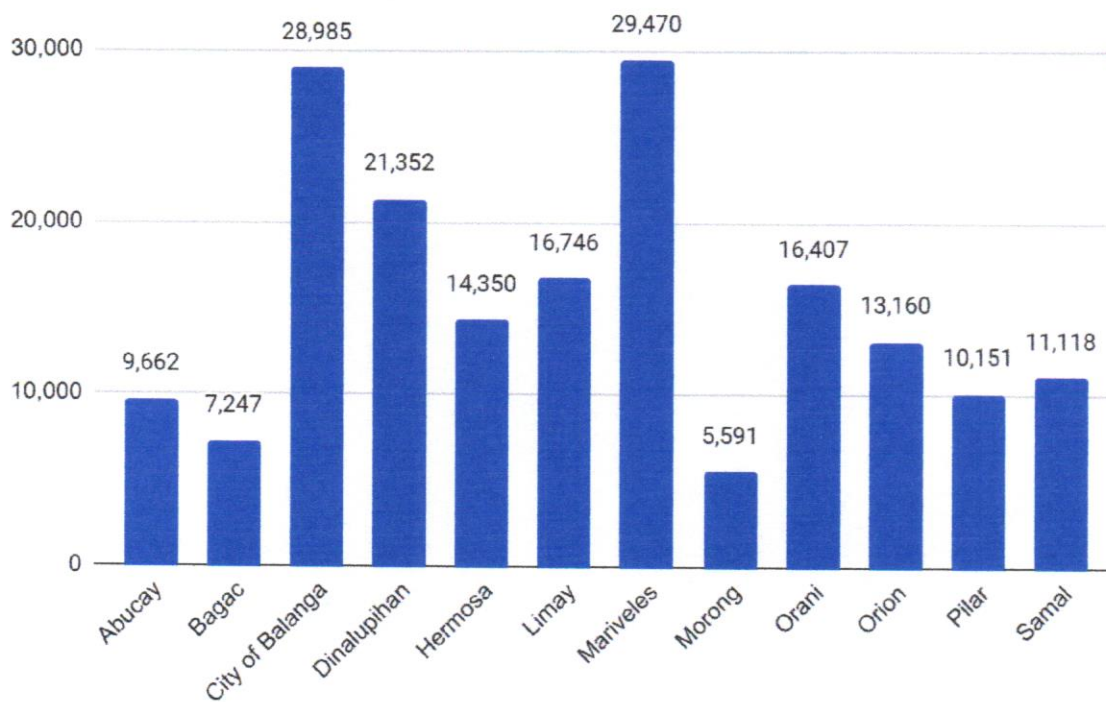

The municipality of Mariveles had the highest numbers issued ePhilID with 29,470, followed by the city of Balanga with 28,985 and municipality of Dinalupihan with 21,352. Morong has the least issued ePhilID with 5,591.



## TECHNICAL NOTES

**PhilSys** - The Philippine Identification System or PhilSys is the government's central identification platform for all Filipino citizens and resident aliens of the Philippines.

**PhilSys Registration Team** – was deployed in far-flung areas to bring PhilSys closer to Filipinos residing in Geographically Isolated and Disadvantaged Areas (GIDA). The team utilized available modes of transport in localities to ensure that Filipinos will be registered to the PhilSys.

**RA 11055 Republic Act No. 11055**, otherwise known as the Philippine Identification System Act, aims to establish a single national identification system for all citizens and resident aliens of the Republic of the Philippines.

**PhilID** – a simple plastic card with overt security features used primarily as a physical medium to convey the PCN, registered demographic data and facial image, and a digitally signed Quick Response (QR) code encoded with demographic data and two beast fingerprint labels.

**Step 2 Registration** - is the validation of supporting documents and collection of biometric information such as iris scan, fingerprints, and front-facing photograph.

**Step 3 PhilID** -is the delivery of the physical PhilID cards to owners by the Philippine Postal Corporation (PHLPost)

**Step 3 ePhilID** – is the issuance of the digital version of the PhilID which is printed on a piece of paper to owners by the PhilSys Registration Team.

**Step 2 Registration Date Initiated** – the operations start in the Province of Bataan on January 26, 2021.

**Step 3 ePhilID Issuance Date Initiated** – ePhilID Issuance started on October 03, 2022.

**Resident Alien** – an individual who is not a citizen of the Philippines but has the appropriate immigrant visa or established residence in the Philippines for an aggregate period of more than 180 days and is in possession of an alien Certificate of Registration (ACR) I – Card.


**Co-locations**- to partnership with other agencies for the registration to Philippine Identification System.

**Saturation**- is a strategy to cover all the unregistered persons in the Philippine Identification System.

**PCN- PhilSys Card Number** is printed on the front of the Philippine ID.

**Authentication** - is a process to ensure a more streamlined and secure method of verifying the identity of a person.

**Family Development Session (FDS)** - this is a program of DSWD to allocate the financial support to the 4Ps beneficiaries.
