It provides quarterly data on employment, compensation, revenue/sales, and inventory for national account estimation. The survey is one of the primary data sources in the compilation of the Quarterly National Accounts (QNA) and the construction of the Quarterly Economic Indicators (QEI).

During the awarding ceremony held at Belle's Catering sa Lumang Bahay, Valdefuente, Cabanatuan City, Ms. Girlie G. De Guzman, OIC—Supervising Statistical Specialist, emphasized the importance of respondents in getting a complete picture of the economy in Nueva Ecija.
