PSA Pampanga conducts the January 2025 Compilation of Data from Slaughterhouses & Poultry Dressing Plant (CDSPDP)




The data collection takes place during the first 10 days of the month and is conducted by statistical researchers from the Philippine Statistics Authority (PSA). The data is obtained from the administrative records of the National Meat Inspection Service (NMIS) and Locally Registered Meat Establishments (LRMEs), which are supervised by Local Government Units (LGUs).

The Compilation of Data from Slaughterhouses and Poultry Dressing Plants (CDSPDP) is one of the regular activities of the Livestock and Poultry Statistics Division (LPSD) under the Economic Sector Statistics Service (ESSS). This is conducted to provide statistics on the number of animals/birds slaughtered/dressed in slaughterhouses or poultry dressing plants. The data generated from this activity:

- a.) serves as indicator/data check in the validation of production estimates for livestock and poultry commodities;
- b.) validates the average carcass weight per animal type; and
- c.) guides the policy makers in crafting policy and program related to meat supply and food safety.
