BOOTS Friday offers a wide range of

services, including bloodletting, optical and oral health services, cervical and breast screening and social service assistance such as late birth registration, national ID registration, PhilHealth applications, legal consultations, Overseas Workers Welfare Administration (OWWA) programs, and a feeding program. During the event, the PSA Tarlac National ID personnel successfully registered fifty (50) residents of Capas, including senior citizens and children aged 0 to 4 years old and above. In addition to the registration process, PSA provided services such as issuance of National ID in paper form, assistance in generating Digital

National ID, and retrieval of Transaction Reference Numbers. Registering for the National ID system facilitates seamless access to government services, healthcare, and social programs. It also provides children with a reliable form of identification as
