## 35th Civil Registration Month Celebration

The celebration of Civil Registration Month in Bulacan officially began on 1 February with the hanging of streamers across the province. A motorcade, followed by the opening ceremony on 3 February, marked the start of the month-long event. The ceremony was attended by PSA personnel, local government units (LGUs), media partners, and various government agencies.

Throughout the month, various activities were held, including a poster-making contest and essay writing contest, with participation from schools across Bulacan. A quiz bee also took place, where Registration Officer II from San Ildefonso won first place at the provincial level, later placing third at the regional level.

An Infomercial Contest was also conducted, with four entries from Bulacan's educational institutions winning regional recognition. From 20-28 February, information campaigns were held in different municipalities, with PSO personnels conducting lectures on civil registration. Additionally, an interview was conducted through the 'Radyo Kapitolyo' platform as part of the information campaign.

The month-long celebration concluded on 28 February with a closing ceremony at Villa Reina Building in Catmon, Malolos, Bulacan. The event was attended by PSO personnel, representatives from LCROs, educational institutions, and government agencies. Awards, including plaques and certificates of recognition, were presented to the winners of the month's activities.

## PhilSys Surpasses February Registration Target

PhilSys achieved a milestone in February by surpassing its registration goal for the National ID. With an initial target of 6,840 registrants, PhilSys successfully registered 12,521 individuals—83% more than expected. This achievement highlights the continuous efforts to improve and speed up the registration process.

## Bulacan Takes Part in Nationwide Labor Force Survey for February 2025

The Philippine Statistics Authority (PSA) - Bulacan conducted the February 2025 Labor Force Survey (LFS) from 8-28 February to gather data assessing the country's employment situation.

Two Statistical Researchers were assigned to cover 102 sample households across six municipalities: San Jose Del Monte, San Miguel, Bocaue, Plaridel, Malolos, and Santa Maria. The survey provided key insights into labor market trends and economic conditions.

On 14 February 2025, the PSO held a conference to present the January 2025 inflation report. The inflation rate slowed to 2.5% from 3.1% in December 2024. Food inflation also dropped to 4.5%, while the purchasing power of the peso remained at Php 0.77. The event, attended by LGUs, government agencies, and partner organizations, was also streamed live on PSO Bulacan's Facebook page to inform stakeholders and the public.
