MAP AND DATA PROCESSING ACTIVITIES AND GEOTAGGING OF SERVICE FACILITIES AND GOVERNMENT PROJECTS (SFGP)



The Provincial Statistical Office of Nueva Ecija is currently conducting the 2024 Census of Population and Community-Based Monitoring System (POPCEN-Map and Data CBMS) Processing activities at the Data Processing Center (DPC), previously located at Belle's, Bahay, Brgy. Valdefuente, Lumang Cabanatuan City, Nueva Ecija, now located at PSO Nueva Ecija Training Room.

As of 30 April 2025, the DPC—led by CBMS Focal Person Senior Statistical Specialist Rommel Payawal and Alternate Focal Statistical Specialist II Aphrodite Ortiz, along with the Information System Analyst and two shift supervisors—has accomplished significant progress in its operations. A total of 2,738 Form 1s have been encoded out of 2,888 enumeration areas (94.80%), 2,888 maps have been processed (100.00%) but is yet to be uploaded, 2,888 data entries validated (100.00%), and 2,888 datasets uploaded (100.00%). Processing of duplicates has also been completed. In addition, the team has completed the encoding of 11,683 forms gathered during phase saturation However, processing of inconsistencies forwarded by the Central Office is still ongoing.

To maximize resources and improve output, the DPC continues to operate on a two-shift rotational schedule. However, during the last two weeks of operations (April 16-30), the number of personnel was reduced to 55 (comprising 53 map data processors and 2 supervisors) due to a limited and reduced workload. Despite this, the team retained the two-shift schedule since the slow processing system could not

accommodate all personnel in a single

To continue tasks not completed between April 16 and 30, the team has set up a temporary DPC at the PSA Training Room. These remaining activities include encoding of Form 1s, uploading of data deduplication, resolution inconsistencies and accomplishment of the certification pass. However, it became apparent that these tasks could not be completed immediately. In response, the CBMS Focal requested a 5-day extension (May 9-15) in which 30 data processors were rehired to ensure completion. To optimize processing, the CBMS team selected the best-performing personnel for this final stretch.

Meanwhile, hired personnel for the Geotagging of Service Facilities and Government Projects (SFGP) began operations on March 10. As of 30 April, Nueva Ecija has successfully geotagged all 849 barangays (100.00%), processed all 849 barangays (100.00%).

This progress has been made under the consistent supervision and monitoring of Senior Statistical Specialist Payawal, Statistical Specialist II Ortiz, and Mapping Focal Person Hilario Delos Santos, under the guidance of OIC Girlie G. De Guzman, to ensure operational efficiency and real-time issue resolution.









<mark>PSA HOUR AT DWNE TELERADYO INTERVIEW</mark>



On April 2, 2025, the Philippine Statistics Authority (PSA) Nueva Ecija attended in a radio guesting and interview for PSA Hour in DWNE Teleradyo at Palayan City, Nueva Ecija. Representing PSA Nueva Ecija Accounts were Statistical Specialist II Aphrodite completed. A. Ortiz for Statistical Unit matters, Registration Officer II Mark Joseph U. Briquela for National ID matters, and Statistical Analyst Gemalyn Fernandez for Civil Registration Services.

SS II Aphrodite A. Ortiz discussed the ongoing and upcoming projects of PSA Nueva Ecija under the Statistical Among the key Unit. highlighted was the 2024 Census of Population and Community-based Monitoring System (POPCEN CBMS), which is currently in the map and data 96% processing stage with completion. This project also conducts the Geotagging of Service Facilities and Government Projects, which is carried out across municipalities and 849 barangays. Additionally, PSA Nueva Ecija is conducting several important surveys part of its regular activities, Palay including the and Production Survey, Rice and Corn Stock Survey, and the Annual Survey Philippine Business Industry (ASPBI). ASPBI includes a rider on Information and Communication



Technology (ICT), which involves surveying 682 establishments with 382 samples.

Other ongoing surveys include the Labor Force Survey, Livestock and Poultry Survey, and the Crops Production Survey. Furthermore, the Provincial Product Accounts project is also underway, with data collection happening and processing collaboration with local government units (LGUs) and other agencies. There was a specific call for data provision. as the Information Dissemination Forum for this year has been moved to an earlier date, now set for October. Over 50% of the data collection for the Provincial Product has already

CHECK AND AUDIT OVER THE LOCAL CIVIL REGISTRY OFFICES



The PSA Nueva Ecija conducted the random check and audit over the Local Civil Registry Offices in the province of Nueva Ecija. For the month of April, 17 out of 32 LCROs have been visited by the PSA Audit Team led by Supervising Statistical Specialist and Officer-in-Charge Girlie G. De Guzman pursuant to the Office Memorandum 2024-264. The activity aims to verify the proper maintenance and safeguarding of civil registry



documents, assess adherence to existing laws, policies and procedures, and identify areas for improvement in LCRO Operations.

Photo documentation of newlywed couples have been properly recorded for official reference.




