

LGU's Efforts Drive Success for May 2025 National Registration Turnout

Zambales, Philippines – June 2025 — The Philippine Statistics Authority (PSA) Zambales National ID Team has achieved an exceptional milestone in May 2025, registering 1,699 individuals—an impressive 217.82% of its original monthly target of 780 registrants. This significant overachievement reflects the strong community participation and the steadfast support of Local Government Units (LGUs) across the province.

The success of the campaign is a testament to the ongoing collaboration between PSA Zambales and its LGU partners, aimed at broadening access to the Philippine Identification System (PhilSys)—a foundational ID system designed to simplify identity verification and promote more efficient delivery of public services.

Olongapo City emerged as the top contributor, registering 713 individuals (41.97%), thanks to the presence of two strategic registration sites: the Olongapo City Hall (Fixed LGU Site) and the PhilSys Fixed Registration Center at Ohio St., Upper Kalaklan, Olongapo City.

Other key contributors included:

- Subic: 504 registrants (29.66%), with a major site at Waltermart Subic
- San Marcelino: 184 registrants, with registration held every Friday at the Municipal Hall
- Castillejos: 153 registrants (9.01%)
- San Narciso: 145 registrants (8.53%)


This multi-location approach proved instrumental in reaching diverse communities, making the registration process more accessible and efficient.

The overwhelming turnout not only highlights the demand for a unified national identification system but also reflects growing public awareness of the PhilSys program's benefits—including improved access to government aid, financial services, and streamlined public transactions.

PSA Zambales continues to encourage all residents, especially those from priority sectors, to participate in upcoming registration drives as it works toward full coverage under the PhilSys initiative.
