Inventory of Livestock and Poultry in Bataan as of 01 April 2025

Date of Release: 02 June 2025 Reference No. 08-SR2025-LS-03

The total inventory of livestock and poultry in the province of Bataan as of 01 April 2025 reached 3,695,180 heads which was 41.77 percent higher than the recorded total inventory of 2,606,424 heads as of 01 April 2024. Livestock inventory as of 01 April 2025 increased by 11.75 percent compared to the inventory as of 01 April 2024. Similarly, poultry inventory also increased by 43.14 percent.




In terms of animal type, carabao and swine increased with 0.95 percent and 45.81 percent. On the other hand, cattle and goat decreased with 7.14 percent and 6.18 percent.

Poultry inventory as of 01 April 2025 increased compared to the inventory as of 01 April 2024. Broiler chicken, and layer chicken recorded an increase of 57.91 percent and 31.92 percent. On the other hand, duck and chicken native/improved inventory decreased by 8.13 and 11.09 percent. (Figure 2).


The inventory of swine showed a upward trend from 01 July 2024 to 01 April 2025, while other animal types had a stagnant trend. (Figure 3)

TECHNICAL NOTES

The Livestock and Poultry Performance Report presents the performance situation in terms of production and inventory of carabao, cattle, goat, swine and by type of chicken, and inventory in the slaughterhouses. Moreover, data for this special release were collected by the Philippine Statistics Authority (PSA) through the two (2) major surveys, namely: Backyard Livestock and Poultry Survey (BLPS) and Commercial Livestock and Poultry Survey (CLPS

Another survey that supplements the data requirements of the Livestock and Poultry sector is the Compilation of Data in Slaughterhouses and Poultry Dressing Plants (CDSPDP). This is done monthly and utilizes administrative data from slaughterhouses in the province which is in coordination with the Provincial Veterinary Office (PVO) and Meat Inspectors (MIs).

Livestock – farm animals kept or raised for consumption, work or leisure. In general, poultry is separated as a distinct group of farm animals. For purposes of census and surveys, livestock covers only those that are tended and raised by an operator.

Poultry - a collective term for all domesticated avian for the purpose of food consumption or, the carcass of such avian dressed/processed for human consumption.

Animal Inventory (also, **Animal Population**) – the number of domesticated animals in head present in the farm at specific reference date.

Backyard Farm/Raiser-refers to any farm or household raising at least one head of animal or bird and does not qualify as a commercial farm.

Dressing-the progressive separation on the dressing floor of food animal into carcass, offal and inedible by- products.

Slaughter- refers to butchering of animal for the purpose of human consumption.

Slaughterhouse/Dressing Plant- the premises that are approved and registered by a controlling authority in which food animals/birds are slaughtered and dressed for human consumption.
