Ang aktibidad na ito ay naisakatuparan sa ilalim ng masigasig na pamumuno ni G. Danilo V. Cruz, OSCA Head ng lungsod.

Matapos ang matagumpay na koordinasyon sa Siyudad ng Gapan, nagpatuloy rin ang grupo sa pakikipag-ugnayan sa iba't ibang OSCA offices sa iba pang lungsod at munisipalidad sa Nueva Ecija. Layunin nitong mas mapalawak pa ang saklaw ng serbisyo at matiyak na walang senior citizen ang mapag-iwanan sa programang ito. 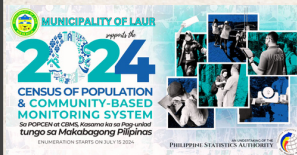

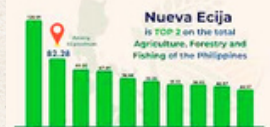

JOB FAIR MEETS PUBLIC SERVICE: NATIONAL ID TEAM ON THE GROUND



In celebration of the 127th Philippine Independence Day, the National ID Team of Nueva Ecija actively participated in the Job Fair held on June 12, 2025, at SM City Cabanatuan, Level 4 Roof Park. Organized in collaboration with various government agencies and private sector partners, the job fair aimed to connect job seekers with employment opportunities while bringing essential government services closer to the public. The National ID team contributed by offering on-site registration, updating of demographic information, and issuance of ePhilIDs. A total of 15 registrants were successfully enrolled for the National ID, 10 individuals had their demographic records updated, and 13 ePhilIDs were issued during the event.

In addition to these services, the National ID Provincial Focal Person conducted an information session addressing frequently asked questions (FAQs) regarding the National ID, including the use of authentication services and other PhilSys-related topics. The discussion helped educate participants on how the National ID can simplify access to both government and private sector services. The National ID Team's participation highlights their continued commitment to improving service accessibility and raising awareness on the benefits of the Philippine Identification System (PhilSys).

JUNE PSA HOUR AT DWNE TELERADYO

On June 4, 2025, PSO Nueva Ecija, through representatives Registration Officer II Niña J. Pangilinan, Registration Officer II Mark Joseph U. Briguela, and Statistical Analyst Shara Mae Bergado attended their monthly first-wednesday interview called "PSA Hour" at DWNE Teleradyo, Palayan City. ROII Pangilinan discussed civil registration activities, including LCRO visits to 32 municipalities, to assess processes and make recommendations for improvement while SA Bergado generously share the upcoming statistical activities, projects and operations. Giving emphasis also on the ongoing operations of the National ID team, Focal Person-ROII Briguela, lead the discussion regarding the registration operations among senior citizens. He highlighted that National ID registration is now a crucial requirement for senior citizens to receive their social welfare benefits and payouts, particularly for those enrolled in programs such as Social Pension and other government-assisted financial aid.



During the interview, Mr. Briguela clarified the process flow of PhilSys registration, explained the documentary requirements, and addressed common concerns raised by the public, particularly on registration delays and ID delivery updates. He also encouraged families to assist their elderly members in completing their registration, underscoring PSA's continuing commitment to make the service more accessible, especially for vulnerable sectors of society.



PSA STUDY VISIT TO DA-PHILRICE, PCC, PHILMECH, AND BFAR

PSA conducted a study visit to various organizations (i.e., Department of Agriculture Philippine Rice Research Institute, Philippine Carabao Center, Philippine Center for Postharvest Development and Mechanization (PhilMech) and Bureau of Fisheries and Aquatic Resources (BFAR) in Science City of Muñoz, Nueva Ecija.



This study visit was conducted to gather relevant information to contribute to strengthened coordination for future collaboration on geospatial analytics, data sharing, and statistical capacity building.



1ST GOVERNANCE FORUM DA-PHILRICE, SCIENCE CITY OF MUÑOZ, NUEVA ECIJA



Philippine Statistics Authority–Nueva Ecija (PSA-NE) proudly participated as a booth exhibitor at the 1st Governance Forum: Enhancing Citizen Access through Inter-Agency Online Services, held last June 23 at DA–PhilRice, Science City of Muñoz.



The team provided National ID registration and updates, civil registration assistance, and distributed IEC materials on PSA-NE's projects and services. Visitors also enjoyed trivia and updates on CBMS, the 2023 Economic Performance of Nueva Ecija, the Palay Situation, and more.



PSO SUPPORT TO ACTIVITIES OF EDUCATIONAL INSTITUTIONS

The Philippine Statistics Authority (PSA) Nueva Ecija conducted a social responsibility program in support of the Brigada Eskwela for the upcoming School Year 2025–2026. Beneficiary schools were Bantug Elementary School in Science City of Muñoz and J.P. Melencio Elementary School in Cabanatuan City.

JOINT OATH-TAKING CEREMONY OF THE NEWLY ELECTED OFFICIALS OF THE PROVINCE OF NUEVA ECIIA



Elected officials in Nueva Ecija took their oath of office simultaneously on 30 June 2025 at the Crystal Waves Event Center in Talavera, Nueva Ecija. This marked the beginning of a new era of political governance in the province.

The event was also attended by various heads and representatives of government agencies in Nueva Ecija. Representing the PSA Provincial Office, the delegation was led by Statistical Specialist II Ria C. Salvador, accompanied by Statistical Analyst Gemalyn L. Fernandez.

The program formally began with a prayer led by Rev. Ricardo De Alban, followed by the singing of the National Anthem and the Nueva Ecija March.

Outgoing Vice Governor Emmanuel

Anthony Umali administered the oath of office to Governor Aurelio Umali for his third term. Governor Umali then led the swearing-in of other elected officials from various towns and cities, including incoming Vice Governor Gil Raymond Umali, 2nd District Congressman Mario "Kokoy" Salvador, and Provincial Board Members.

Newly elected Vice Governor Raymond Umali and Governor Aurelio Umali both delivered speeches emphasizing the significance of the oath of office and the duty to serve the people. They also highlighted that, despite differences in political affiliations, officials must work together for the progressive development of the province.

DA-REGIONAL FIELD OFFICE III AND PHILIPPINE STATISTICS AUTHORITY (PSA) - REGION III AGRICULTURAL CONSULTATION MEETING

The Department of Agriculture – Regional Field Office III held a consultation meeting with the Philippine Statistics Authority – Central Luzon on 30 June 2025 to present its interventions and align plans for boosting agricultural production and reducing costs, aiming to ensure accurate assistance for farmers in Central Luzon.

PSA RSSO III's delegation, led by Statistical Specialist Arlene Z. Torrico, presented on the Rice Program's achievements for the 2nd Quarter of 2025, including palay planting, seed distribution, fertilizer voucher allocation, and financial assistance to farmers. Mr. Lowell D. Rebillaco also discussed the Philippine Rice Information System (PRISM), a decision-support system used to monitor rice crop growth and assess potential yields, highlighting the importance of rice-planted areas.

The High Value Crops Development Program (HVCDP) implementation



for the 1st Semester of 2025 was discussed by HVCDP Coordinator AB P. David, who presented budget allocations and data analysis. Corn Program Coordinator Melody Nombre discussed the White and Yellow Corn Enhancement Program, which provided farm production support to farmers. Livestock Coordinator Agnes Uera discussed key initiatives in the livestock sector, including UNAIP, PNAD, and LEED, aimed at boosting livestock productivity and supporting rural livelihoods. Participants were encouraged to ask questions and share concerns.



SOCD Chief Statistical Specialist Arlene Z. Torrico praised DA-RFO III for organizing a consultation meeting, highlighting the importance of understanding farmers' conditions. She hoped for future engagements and encouraged regular consultations to produce accurate statistics for evidence-based planning and government intervention delivery.



BIRTH REGISTRATION ASSISTANCE PROJECT AS OF JUNE 2025



Birth Registration Assistance Project is a program of Philippine Statistics Authority (PSA) that aims to increase the level of birth registration, especially in marginalized communities such as those belonging to the Indigenous Peoples (IPs), Muslim Filipinos, and the poorest sector in the country. It also aims to ensure that these groups are enrolled in the Philippine Identification System and have been issued with their Philippine Identification (PhilID) card which is a gateway for them to claim their social benefits and legal identity.



For the month of June 2025, the provincial office undertook various activities to continuously provide a list of unregistered individuals, Coordination to LGU's to reach the target registrants as well as the awarding of successfully registered Local Certificate of Live birth and COLB printed in SecPa.

As of June 30, 2025 a total of 2,994 individuals have already registered in our province. Out of this number 1,725 are in Electronic Endorsement, 381 are Out-of-Town while the remaining 888 went through regular process.

As we continuously conducted mobile registration under the Birth Registration Assistance Project (BRAP), we encountered the common problems in registering such as difficulty in inviting registrants, no/lack of requirements, unavailability of registrants during weekdays and among others.

CONTINUOUS SUPPORT TO ACTIVITIES OF LOCAL GOVERNMENT UNITS AND OTHER AGENCIES

The Local Civil Registrar Office of Bongabon and Sto. Domingo invited Supervising Statistical Specialist and Officer-in-Charge Girlie G. 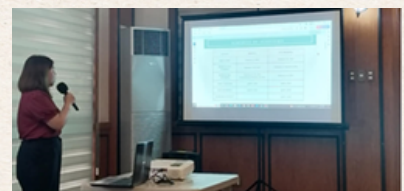
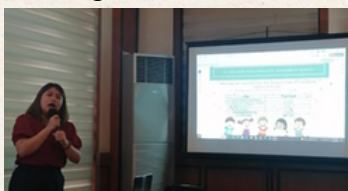
(PCPC) Meeting
