ONE ID, MANY OPPORTUNITIES: "NATIONAL ID TEAM ACTIVE IN NUEVA ECIJA JOB EVENTS"



National ID Nueva Ecija Team The actively participated in two major job fair events in the province last May 2025, aiming to register job seekers for the system National ID and promote awareness of its benefits. On May 1, 2025, the team joined the 123rd Job Fair Celebration in partnership with TESDA at SM Cabanatuan City. The event attracted numerous job seekers, offering them the opportunity to register for the National ID, learn about its advantages, and access employment services. The team provided registration on-site assistance and information dissemination, supporting the government's efforts to streamline identification processes and enhance employment facilitation.

Following this, the team participated in the General De Jesus College Job Fair on May 6, 2025, in San Isidro, Nueva Ecija. This initiative further expanded outreach, encouraging more residents to register for their National IDs and become aware of the convenience and security it offers. The Nueva Ecija team remains committed



to promoting the National ID system, ensuring accessibility, and supporting local employment initiatives. Through these efforts, the team aims to foster a more inclusive and efficient identification system across the province.

In line with this commitment, the team will also be participating in the upcoming Job Fair on June 12, 2025, further extending registration services and continuing to raise awareness about the National ID and its benefits.

BIRTH REGISTRATION ASSISTANCE PROJECT (BRAP)





The Birth Registration Assistance Project (BRAP) aims to increase the level of civil registration especially in marginalized communities such as those belonging to the indigenous peoples, Muslim Filipinos and the poorest sector of society. Priorities for registration are persons who do not have any certificate of live birth.

The project is in support to the national campaign of the Office of the Civil Registrar General to improve civil registration and to attain the three goals of the Civil Registration and Vital Statistics which are: universal civil registration of births, deaths, and other vital events; all individuals with legal documentation to claim identity, civil status, and ensuring rights and accurate, complete and timely vital registration are produced and disseminated.

For the month of May 2025, the provincial office undertook various activities to continuously provide a unregistered individuals, information list of dissemination and coordination to LGU's to reach the target registrants as well as the awarding of successfully registered Local Certificate of Live birth and COLB printed in SecPa.

As of this month, a total of 16,408 possible unregistered individuals (list of possible registrants) were submitted by the LCROs to the provincial office, and were then forwarded to the Central Office. Out of this number, a total of 15,564 birth records had been verified, wherein 11,025 have no birth records, while 4,539 yielded positive results, meaning they were

already registered and in the database while 844 are still waiting for the results of the verification.

The youngest that we were able to register was a 5month-old baby boy from Gabaldon and the oldest was 74-year-old Nanay Dalisay Benitez Mari of Brgy. Malacañang Santa Rosa, Nueva Ecija who even sent her document to Cabanatuan City, Nueva Ecija through out-of-town endorsement. We also sent (2) two requirements of registrants to the Central Office for evaluation because they are 80 years old and above and when the result arrives and is approved, it will be sent to the respective municipality for the continuation of their registration.

A total of 91 possible registrants were requested for verification of status in the CRS database for the month of May 2025 through BRAP, the initial step is verified free of charge to the PSA.

In Out-of-Town Delayed Registration of Certificates of Live Birth, the provincial office of Nueva Ecija received a total of 15 from other provinces to be processed in the different City/Municipality of our province.

As of May 30, 2025 a total of 2,899 individuals have already registered in our province. Out of this number 1,700 are in Electronic Endorsement, 368 are Out-of- Town while the remaining 831 went through regular process.

As we continuously conducted mobile registration under Birth the Registration Assistance Project (BRAP), we encountered the common problems in registering such as difficulty in inviting registrants, no/lack of requirements, unavailability of registrants during weekdays and among others.




