Update on National Identification System Registration in Bataan as of June 2025

Total Registrants as of 30 June 2025

A total registrant of 738,455 Bataeños have been registered in the National Identification System Step 2 in the Province of Bataan. Table 1 shows that 86.53% of the provincial target (853,373) has been successfully registered in the National Identification System. It is composed of 142,793 who are 0 to 14 years old and 595,662 who are 15 years old and above.

A total registrant of 3,135 Bataeños have been registered for the month of June 2025 in the National ID Step 2 in the Province of Bataan. Table 2 shows that 167.20% of the target workload for the month of June 2025 (1875) was successfully registered in the National ID System.

Registrants per Municipality

The City of Balanga tops the highest registrants with 112.85% based on the target from 2020 Census of Population and Housing (117,563 registrants out of 104,173 population). In the City of Balanga located the National ID fixed registration center which accommodates the registrants in the whole province of Bataan. Next, the municipality of Orani at 89.99% (63,298 out of 70,342) placing the second highest accomplishment. Then, the municipality of Samal with 89.97% (34,461 out of 38,302). The least reported percentage of accomplishment was Mariveles at 75.51% (113,121 out of 149,809).

Figure 1. Total Registrants in the National Identification System Step 2 by Municipality: Bataan

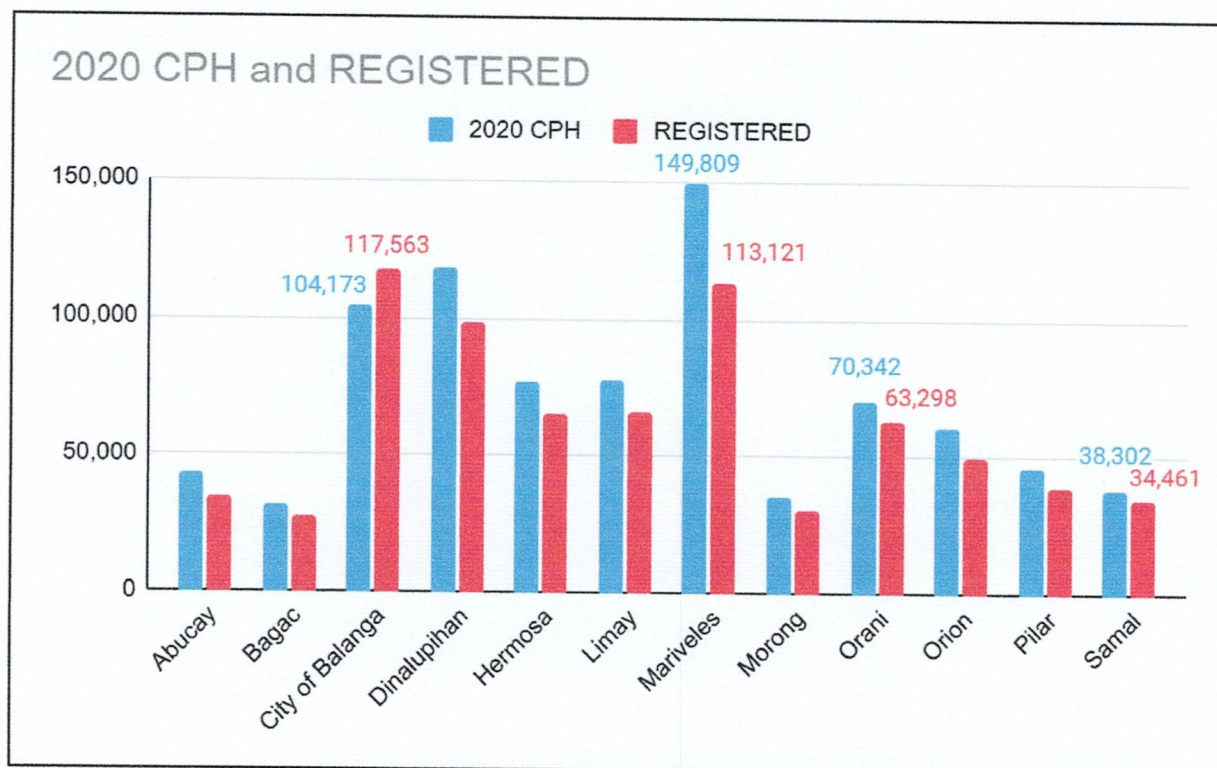
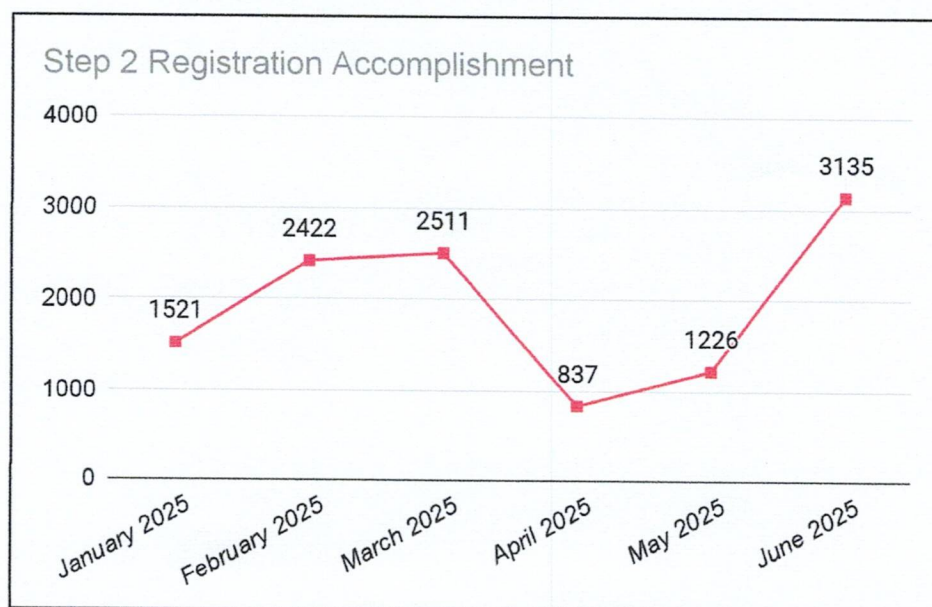


Figure 2. Number of Registrants in the National Identification System Step 2 by Month, Bataan January 2025 to June 2025.



The number of registrants increased significantly during the month of June 2025 due to the increase in numbers of workload for the second quarter; given that we have four (4) registration kits in the three (3) districts of Bataan and one (1) registration kit in the fixed registration center at the Bunker. Coordination with the Local Government Units (LGUs), Department of Social Welfare and Development (DSWD) Bataan, Department of Education Bataan (DepEd), and Bataan General Hospital and Medical Center (BGHMC) to conduct National ID registration and authentication of National ID Card Number, issuance of ePhilID, and saturation of the area was done this month. PSA Bataan went to far-flung areas to extend the services provided. Figure 2 illustrates the number of registered individuals from January 2025 to June 2025. The total is 1,521 in January, 2,422 in February, 2,693 in March, 838 in April 2025, 1,227 in May and 3,135 in June 2025.

National ID Step 3- Delivery of Philippine ID

Concerning the total number of received PhilIDs, all PhilIDs with the Post Office were delivered . In total, 100% delivered and 5,563 return-to-sender endorsements to PSA Regional Office.

National ID Step 3- Issuance of ePhilID

The ePhilID issued in the province up to this month was 1,247 out of 2,220 target ePhilID based on the total number of workload for Step 2 Registration from April to June 2025, the figure is equivalent to 56.17% issued of the target as of June 2025. This table shows that the target output was not yet met in the prescribed period as most of the registrants opted to create Digital ID by themselves rather than visiting registration centers. The registration team continues to serve the Bataeños on the same day issuance of ePhilID after the step 2 registration.

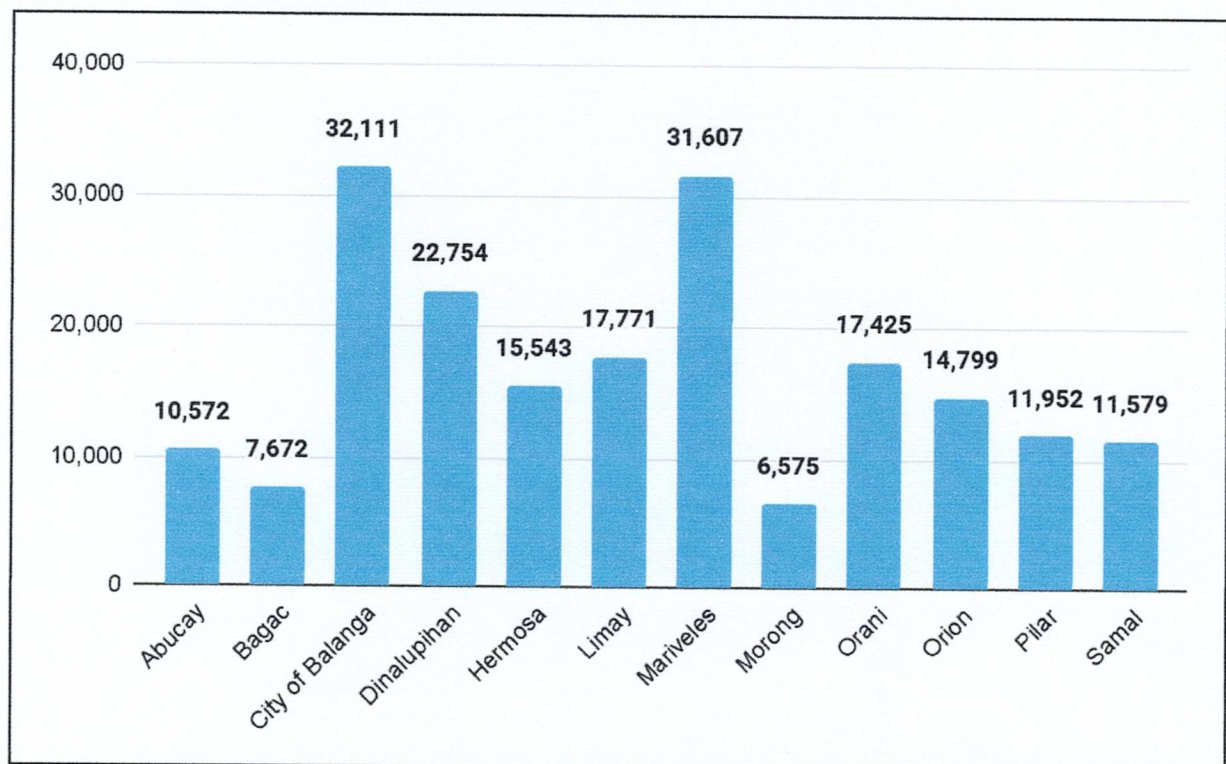

The City of Balanga had the highest numbers issued ePhilID with 302, followed by the municipality of Limay with 87, municipality of Pilar with 37, municipality of Dinalupihan with 28 and municipality of Abucay with 14 issued ePhilID. Other municipalities such as Orani, Hermosa, Mariveles, Samal, Orion, Bagac and Morong had not issued ePhilID due to poor internet connectivity in the registration areas and the undergoing maintenance with the ePhilid system portal.

The city of Balanga had the highest numbers issued ePhilID with 32,111 followed by the municipality of Mariveles with 31,607, and municipality of Dinalupihan with 22,754. Morong has the least issued ePhilID with 6,575.



TECHNICAL NOTES

PhilSys - The Philippine Identification System or PhilSys is the government's central identification platform for all Filipino citizens and resident aliens of the Philippines.

PhilSys Registration Team – was deployed in far-flung areas to bring PhilSys closer to Filipinos residing in Geographically Isolated and Disadvantaged Areas (GIDA). The team utilized available modes of transport in localities to ensure that Filipinos will be registered to the PhilSys.

RA 11055 Republic Act No. 11055, otherwise known as the Philippine Identification System Act, aims to establish a single national identification system for all citizens and resident aliens of the Republic of the Philippines.

PhilID – a simple plastic card with overt security features used primarily as a physical medium to convey the PCN, registered demographic data and facial image, and a digitally signed Quick Response (QR) code encoded with demographic data and two biometric fingerprint labels.

Step 2 Registration - is the validation of supporting documents and collection of biometric information such as iris scan, fingerprints, and front-facing photograph.

Step 3 PhilID - is the delivery of the physical PhilID cards to owners by the Philippine Postal Corporation (PHLPost)

Step 3 ePhilID – is the issuance of the digital version of the PhilID which is printed on a piece of paper to owners by the PhilSys Registration Team.

Step 2 Registration Date Initiated – the operations start in the Province of Bataan on January 26, 2021.

Step 3 ePhilID Issuance Date Initiated – ePhilID Issuance started on October 03, 2022.

Resident Alien – an individual who is not a citizen of the Philippines but has the appropriate immigrant visa or established residence in the Philippines for an aggregate period of more than 180 days and is in possession of an alien Certificate of Registration (ACR) I – Card.

Co-locations- to partnership with other agencies for the registration to Philippine Identification System.

Saturation- is a strategy to cover all the unregistered persons in the Philippine Identification System.


PCN- PhilSys Card Number is printed on the front of the Philippine ID.

Authentication - is a process to ensure a more streamlined and secure method of verifying the identity of a person.

Family Development Session (FDS) - this is a program of DSWD to allocate the financial support to the 4Ps beneficiaries.

PhilSys Registration Kit - refers to the materials and equipment used by the Philippines Statistics Authority (PSA) to collect demographic and biometric data from individuals during the National ID registration process.

Bataan General Hospital and Medical Center (BGHMC) - is the first institution co-located with PSO Bataan for National ID registration.
