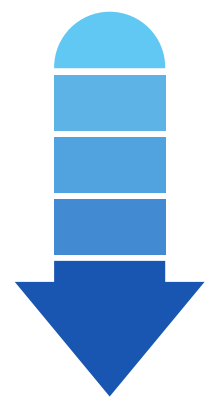


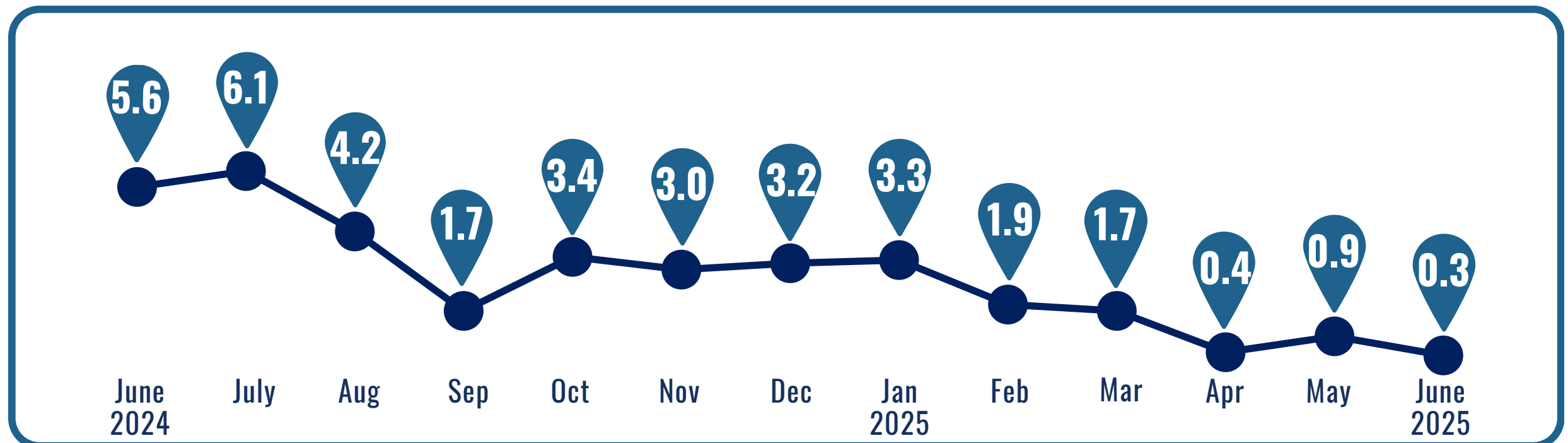
### Inflation Rate for the Bottom 30% Income Households

**0.9%** (MAY 2025)

Based on the "relative poverty" concept, a household whose per capita income falls below the bottom 30% of the cumulative per capita distribution belongs to the low-income group.

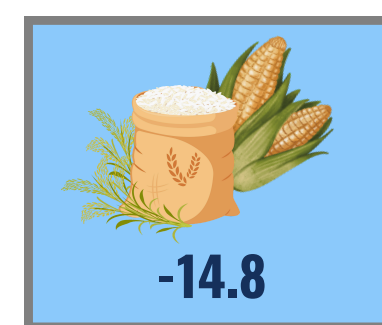

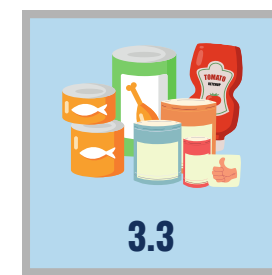
