

After reaching 10.6% in February 2025, the inflation index for meat and other parts of slaughtered land animals decreased to 10.1% in March. Moreover, fish and other seafood increased from 5.5% in February 2025 to 8.3% in March 2025, while vegetables, tubers, etc. decreased from 9.5% to 5.9%.
